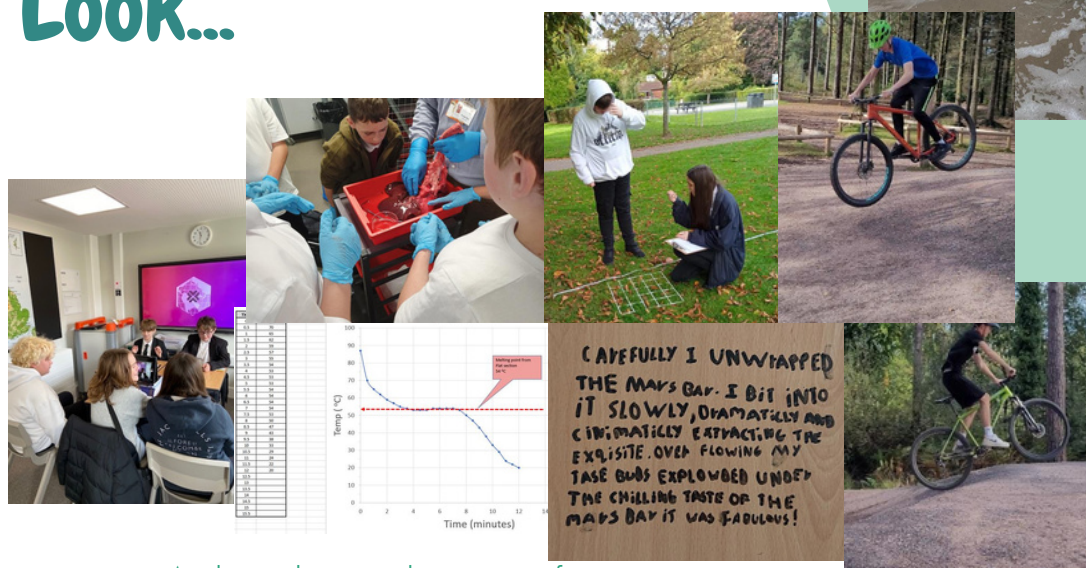


Beach Day for Bella!

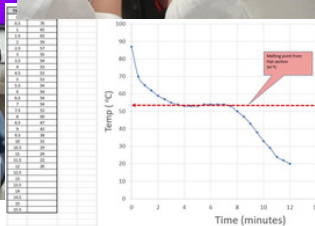
Miss Sargent and Miss Shingler took our therapy dog Bella along to the surfing intervention this week. Her first time at the beach and she's already mastered the waves!
