We've been having a marvellously creative time in Design and Technology exploring the artist Romero Britto and creating our own unique illustrations inspired by his work, this has been particularly successful with one of our Year 10 students who is taking commissions from staff to create works of art for their classrooms.

McGuinness have been exploring the workshop building their confidence in using the Pillar Drill and Belt Sander to make fantastic Wooden Fidget Cubes and Wooden Tic Tac Toe Games, which have been so successful that some of our Year 8 and 9 students have requested to make them.

Year 9 and 10 students have been experimenting with Tie Dye techniques and creating the most truly spectacular fabric, which is either in the process of being Appliqued onto or students have been developing their Screen-Printing skills and printed a hand cut image onto them. The fabric has then been successfully transformed into a super comfy cushion or drawstring rucksack using the sewing machine.

A variety of students and Miss Jones have been creating bespoke Mother's Day wooden candle holders, experimenting with the Gerbil cutter to engrave them and a variety of painting techniques to make them unique.

We have been embracing 'All Things Alice' and constructed our very own White Rabbit.

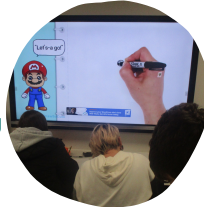
Students in all year groups have been taking apart a variety of different electronic equipment to discover how they are made and then transforming the parts into their own creations. We've also got some expert wire strippers who have been collecting lots of copper to turn into something AMAZING...

Einstein and Dawson have been learning all about Smart Materials, exploring Fake Snow, Bouncy Putty and Polymorph to name but a few.

We have a lot of talented illustrators at ACE and have discovered a wonderful channel which gives us step by step instructions on how to create a range of cartoon characters, this has proven to be a wonderfully mindful activity allowing our students to get lost in the world of drawing.

Clay work, couching, hand embroidery, crochet, designing and making our own games, sock puppets, tin can lamps and jewellery making have also all been happening in the workshop.

It's been marvellous watching our students develop into creative individuals, I can't wait to see what our next creations are...

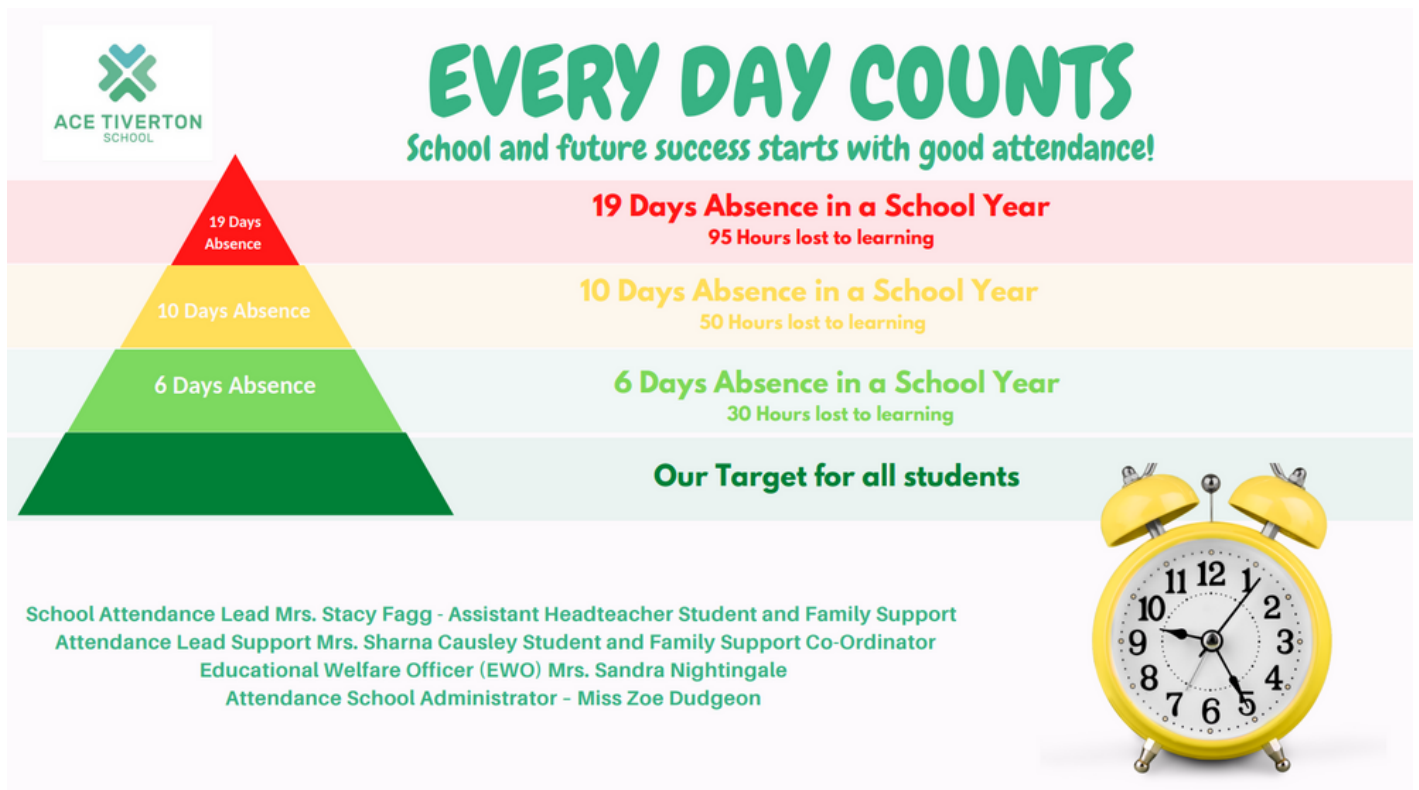

If you want to get confidential or anonymous (no one asks your name) help, these organisations can help.

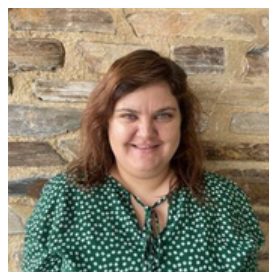
