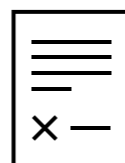

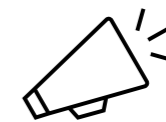
Following the school rules.



Not damaging school property or other students' belongings.



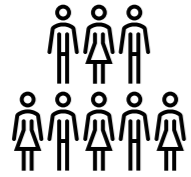
Keeping to an acceptable noise levels so others can concentrate.



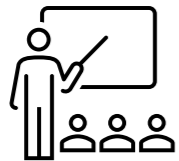
Keeping areas where we eat e.g the dining hall and Forum, tidy and not making a mess.  
with food.



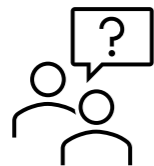
Being true to yourself

your feelings.



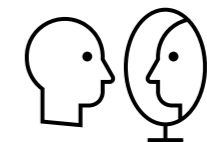
