

ACE: Action and Communication Expectations

These expectations apply to all members of our community and our visitors. We come to school to feel safe, cared for and supported. These expectations apply to students and staff whenever they are in contact with each other, including face to face, on the 'phone and via social media – inside or outside of school hours. If our experience is different to this, then we speak up and share our worries with an adult that we trust.

At ACE Tiverton we expect everyone to act with respect and kindness.

- Respect Yourself: Working to the best of our ability, every lesson, every day.
- ✓ Respect Others: Treating others as we wish to be treated.



- ✓ Respect our Environment by using resources in a calm and safe way.
- ✓ Respect others by staying outside of other people's personal spaces.
- ✓ Respect Others: Holding doors open if there is someone walking through them.

 Respect Yourself by using words to express your feelings before they become overwhelming.



- ✓ Respect Others by speaking calmly and at an appropriate volume.
- Respect Others by taking turns in a conversation, even if the topic isn't very interesting to us.
- Respect our Environment by saying hello or smiling when you see someone, even if you've seen them before.
- ✓ Respect Others by offering to help if you see someone struggling.

If this is not possible, we will provide support for you. Please speak to any adult who will help you find a solution or the most appropriate person to support you.

We can't solve a problem we don't know about, if you are struggling, we will help you.
