



ACE Tiverton Uniform Expectations 2025

Our students take pride in belonging to ACE Tiverton School; to help reinforce a focus on learning and to enhance the sense of belonging to our learning family, we expect all students to wear school uniform.

Black skirt, Black trousers (No Jeans)
White polo shirt, White T shirt or White shirt
Cardigan, Hoodie, Fleece or Jumper Colour Options: Ash Grey or Jade Or Blazer with logo & Tie
Black shoes or trainers No Crocs (unless non-uniform day)

Uniform rules are limited but reinforced through communication with the student, home and a focus on positive reinforcement linked to our Three R's approach: respecting self, others, and our school community. We will only allow approved hoodies such as those available from [Stitch to Print](#). If a hood or cap is part of a student's regulation strategy, part of our transition plan will be to reduce the reliance on this and find a suitable alternative from within our uniform options. We do not allow jeans, this is a conscious choice to support our students in preparing for adulthood and the demands of future learning, employment or training roles which require specific types of clothing to be worn. If student arrive at school with clothing that is not with in our school uniform policy, we will provide student with school uniform for them to wear while in school for that day and they can return it at the end of the school day.

We do not allow logos as part of our student's uniform. Items that make up a student's school wear should be robust, easy to wash and be able to withstand the physicality of active learning. We do not want items of high value to be damaged while learning nor a reason for a student to not participate.

All items of clothing should be clearly marked with the student's name. PE Kit should be kept in a clearly marked drawstring bag that can be kept in student lockers.
